Los verbos en una oracion expresan la accion. Expresan lo que el sujeto está haciendo o sintiendo. Pueden expresar la accion en presente, pasado y futuro. En ingles pueden ser regulares o irregulares. Todos los verbos regulares no cambian su conjugacion excepto en el tiempo pasado agregando "ed" o "d" (ej: walk/ walked, o stare/ stared). Los verbos irregulares cambian a distintas formas en el tiempo pasado (ej: think/ thought o run/ ran, etc.). Existen 12 verbos llamados auxiliares que ayudan a la construcción de oraciones en inglés (be, do, have, can, will, etc.). El tiempo se usa para expresar cuando sucede una acción. **Presente:** la acción está sucediendo en ese momento. Se forma usando el infinitivo en todas las personas excepto la tercera persona - aquí se agrega una "s" (I walk, you walk, he walks, we walk, you walk, they walk). Si la terminación del verbo es "ss", "ch", "sh", "x", se agrega "es" a la tercera persona. Si termina en "y" se cambia la "y" por "i" y se agrega "es". **Presente Continuo:** expresa algo que está sucediendo al estar hablando. Se forma con el presente del verbo "to be" más el participio presente del verbo: I am speaking, we are jumping. **Presente Intensivo:** la acción del verbo puede y debe realizarse. Se forma usando el auxiliar "do" o "does" con el infinitivo: I do stop, they do read. **Presente Perfecto:** es una acción que pasó en el pasado y concluye al presente. Se forma con el auxiliar "have/ has" y el participio pasado del verbo: I have arrived, he has eaten. Enfatiza el hecho más no el momento de la acción. **Pasado:** describe una acción que ocurre en un momento anterior al presente. Se forma agregando "d" al infinitivo si éste termina en vocal o "ed" si éste termina en consonante. Si termina en "y" cambia esta a "i" y se agrega "ed". **Pasado Perfecto:** describe una acción que concluye antes de cierto tiempo en el pasado o antes de iniciar otra acción. Se forma con el pasado del auxiliar "have" (had) junto con el participio pasado del verbo: I had loved. **Pasado Continuo:** describe una acción que estaba sucediendo en el pasado; se forma usando el auxiliar "to be" en su tiempo pasado simple "was/were" y el participio pasado del verbo: I was reading, we were playing. **Pasado Intensivo:** enfatiza el hecho que una acción sí sucedió en el pasado. También se usa para negaciones o preguntas en el tiempo pasado. Combina "did" (pasado del auxiliar "do") con el infinitivo del verbo: you did have, they did eat. **Futuro:** describe una acción que aún no existe pero que sucederá más adelante. Se forma con el auxiliar "will/shall" y el infinitivo del verbo: I will discover, he will eat. El modo subjuntivo describe algo hipotético o irreal. A menudo se usa después de palabras como "if", "as if", "though", "wish", "suppose". Ej: If I left... El futuro subjuntivo se refiere a una acción que podría hacerse realidad. Ej: If we should return... El modo imperativo se usa para dar una orden o exigir algo: "jump-brnca", "stop-alto", "go-ve", etc. **Voz Activa:** sucede cuando el sujeto ejecuta la acción del verbo. Ej: John hit the car. **Voz Pasiva:** la acción del verbo le sucede al sujeto de la oración. Ej: The car was hit by John. Todos los verbos se pueden expresar en voz pasiva, excepto en los tiempos perfectos continuos.
