- How

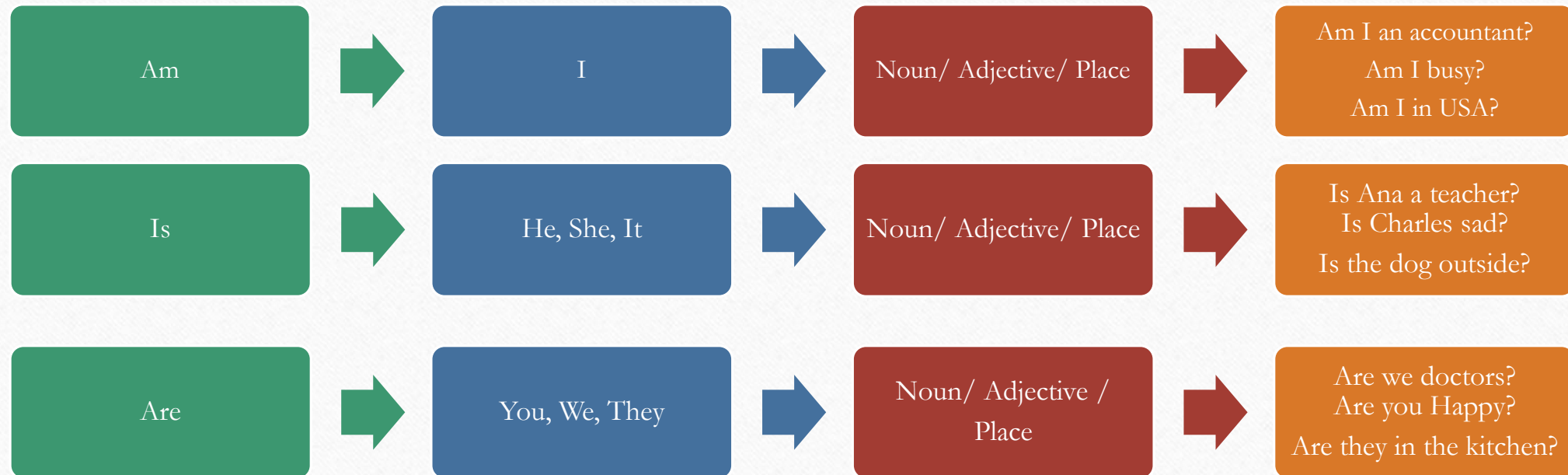
Example:

- How are you?



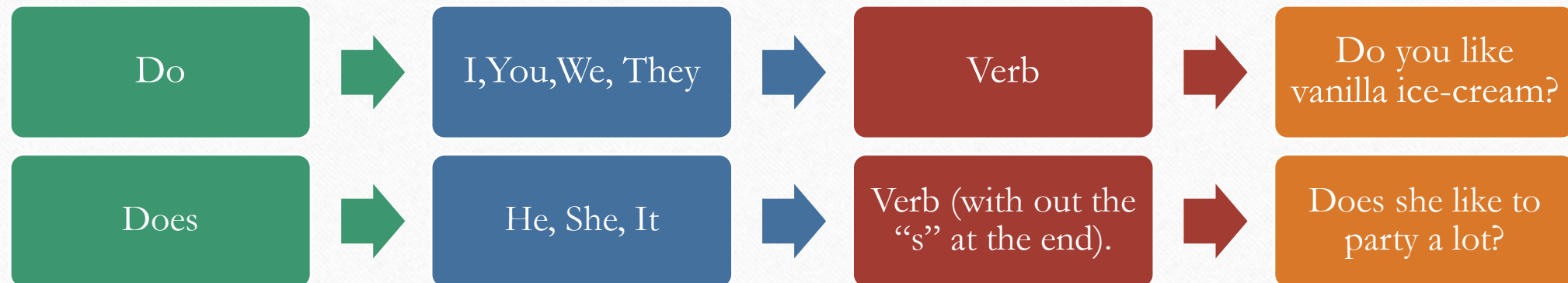
Questions with am, is, are.

Was and Were questions. Refer to past events.



WAS

I, He, She, It.

Was I beautiful when I was Young?

WERE

We, You, They.

Were you at the bar yesterday?

Formula for asking WH questions.

Wh question (What, who, when ...)

Verb to be (Be, was / were)
Do- Does
Did
Have

Pronoun (I, you, we, he, she, it, they)

Complement



What	Does	She	Do?	The question is in present simple.
What	Are	You	Doing?	The question is in present continuous.
What	were	You	Doing yesterday?	The question is in simple past.
What	Are	Your	Plans for the future?	The question is in simple present.
What	Are	You	Going to do tomorrow?	The question is in future.
What	Have	You	Been doing?	The question is in present perfect continuous.
